### IMPORTANT SAFETY RULES TO FOLLOW

- 1. Do not raise the boom unless machine is level. Do not set the machine up on a surface where it cannot be leaved using only the outriggers. This lift is for firm compacted surfaces.
- 2. Do not adjust outriggers while platform is occupied or raised.
- 3. Do not move machine while the platform is raised.
- 4. Do not place or attach overhanging loads to any part of this machine.
- $5. \ \ Do \ not \ place \ or \ attach \ ladders \ in \ platform \ or \ against \ any \ part \ of \ this \ lift.$
- 6. Do not use this machine to lift material or equipment.
- 7. Do Not raise the boom when wind speeds may exceed  $28\ \text{mph}$ .
- 8. Do Not increase the surface area of the platform or load. Increasing the area exposed to the wind will decrease machine stability and can cause it to tip over!
- 9. Do not sit, stand, or climb on platform guardrails. Both feet must always be on the platform!
- 10. Do not exit platform while raised.
- 11. This machine is <u>not</u> electrically insulated and <u>will not</u> provide protection from contact with electrical current.
- 12. Maintain a safe distance from any power lines. (see chart below)
- 13. Keep all personnel away from machine when operating, raising, or lowering.
- 14. Do not leave machine unattended at any time.
